School Assemblies/ cultural programs and sports activities **will not be** conducted, as it is strictly prohibited.

Students will strictly come in school Uniform, with properly trimmed hairs and nails, strictly following all the uniform directions and regulations.

No Mobile phones/tablets/Camera will be allowed with the students, while in the school. Once confiscated, it will not be returned for the next 6 months.

Only asymptomatic persons (teachers, employees and students) are permitted in the school premises. If a teacher/employee/student is found to be symptomatic, he/she will be referred to nearest health centre.

- ❖ Classes will be held on 6 days a week (Monday through Saturday). School Timing will be as usual. 11.15 AM to 4.00 PM (Noon Shift). Classes will be held with 50% capacity on an odd and even roll number basis. Roll Numbers are available in the students profile in the school app.
- ❖ **Odd Roll Numbers:** 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, etc Students with odd roll Numbers will have class on **Monday, Wednesday and Friday**. **Even Roll Numbers:** 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, ... etc., will have classes on **Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday**. Even if a holiday falls on this day, no exception will be made to this arrangement. This arrangement will be in effect until further announcement.
- ❖ Though attendance is not mandatory, all the students are encouraged to be present. **Students will come to school provided their parents / guardians have no objection and such a written undertaking / consent should be produced by the students. (Both the formats can be downloaded from school website). Students are expected to produce the consent form on their first day at school.**
- ❖ Classes VIII - XII will not have online classes. Only class notes will be made available in the e-content of parentsalarm portal.
- ❖ **Transportation (to and fro) will be available for students Registered for School Transport.**
- ❖ **While in the school campus the Students Shall Ensure that:**
 1. The Generic Preventive measures need to be observed by all (teachers, employees and students) while in the school at all times.
 2. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet must be followed.
 3. **Use of face covers/masks is mandatory.** (No mask No Entry)
 4. Wash your hands frequently with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitisers (for at least 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible. All are expected to carry their sanitisers in addition to what is provided by the school.
 5. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing / sneezing with a tissue / handkerchief / flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.

6. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest.
7. Spitting is strictly prohibited.
8. Sharing of items like notebook, pens/pencil, eraser, water bottle etc. amongst students will not be allowed.

The Teaching Faculty will ensure that they themselves and students wear masks for any in-person activity.
