Notice to the Students and Parents

The ISC and ICSE 2020 examinations could not be completed due to Lockdown undertaken by the govt. to contain the COVID-19 pandemic situation. Some subjects / papers could not be held and so the Council had decided to hold the remaining examinations from 1st July 2020.

But according to the Press Release by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi on 15th June 2020, the candidates of ISC and ICSE 2020, has been given two options:

1. **Option 1:** The candidates of ISC and ICSE 2020 Examinations can appear their remaining papers / subjects as per the timetable starting from 1st and 2nd July 2020.

Result of Exam: The Final Results of the Candidates who will be taking the July 2020 Examinations will be decided on the marks obtained in the examination they have appeared, as usual.

2. **Option 2:** The candidates can opt out from July 2020 Examination for the remaining subjects / papers.

Result of the exam: The Final Results of the candidates, who will not appear in the July 2020 Examinations for the remaining papers, will be declared based on the marks of internal assessment / marks of Pre-Board Examinations / Marks obtained in the other papers or subjects already conducted in Feb-March 2020.

The council will use their own method to decide upon marks of the remaining papers. The marks of the remaining papers / subjects will be based on the Internal Assessment Marks / Pre-Board Examination Marks / Marks obtained in the subjects already appeared during February–March 2020. The marks of the remaining subjects / papers will be solely decided by the Council and the school will not have any say or role in it.

The council has requested the students and their parents to inform the school about their option (not willing to appear their exam) in writing to the Principal by 23rd June 2020, Tuesday by 4.00 pm.
