Q1 How many nations are there currently in the United Nations? What are the official languages recognised by the UN?

(Q4) What is Veto?

Ans A vote against any resolution in the Security Council by a permanent member is called a veto.

(Q5) What are the functions of the Secretary-general?

Ans The functions of the Secretary-general are as follows:-

i) The Secretary general, who is the chief administrative officer of the UN.

(ii) The Secretary general does the administrative work and the paperwork of the UN.

(iii) The Secretary general helps resolves international disputes, oversees peace-keeping operations etc.
